
Personal statement and motivation letters

* The German Egyptian Research Short term Scholarship GERSS is a programme, jointly funded by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research (MHESR) and the German Academic Exchange Service, (DAAD) in order to finance short term scholarships for young Egyptian scientists in Germany. The call for application will be opened on the 15th of October 2019

- * he target group of the programme are researchers enrolled in MSc, PhD programs and young Post-Doctoral candidates, who are fulfilling the eligibility criteria of the Egyptian Central Mission Department. The scholarships may be awarded for a period from three to six months.
- * The scholarship shall enable advanced graduate students and young scientists to pursue part of their master's, doctoral or post-doctoral research in a specific research project at German universities, archives, libraries or research institutes.

* Who can apply?

- * The programme is aimed at Master's students, doctoral candidates and young postdocs. The application is also open to non-public university staff members; however, all GERSS applicants should be affiliated to a private or public Egyptian university or Egyptian research institute. Scholarships are not awarded for general-information gathering, visits or for the participation in scientific meetings.
- * What can be funded?
- * This programme funds research visits to a research institute, a state or state-recognised private university in Germany.
- Duration of the funding
- * The scholarships are awarded for a period of 3-6 months. Scholarship periods are not extendable.
