The ethics of scientific research in the Faculty

The department complies with the Code of Ethics of Scientific Research in the College, which stipulates commitment, integrity and scientific honesty, respect for intellectual property rights, cooperation and collective action. These values and principles represent the framework through which the department seeks to achieve research priorities in the next five years. The foundations of scientific research ethics in the faculty are as follows:

- 1. The researcher presents the subject of research to the Research Ethics Committee.
- 2. The researcher should refrain from using deception in obtaining information.

- 3. The researcher should take into account the honesty in presenting the results in a direct and uncoordinated manner and does not provide false, artificial or incorrect results, evidence, results, misleading conclusions or comments.
- 4. The researcher should Avoid any kind of discrimination when selecting his assistants in the research.
- 5. Research should include only the names of the researchers who participated in the research, with a precise identification of their respective roles.
- 6. On who: the research arbitrator must have a high level of theoretical and scientific information and check the references so that he can make a good objective evaluation of the research. He must be impartial and objective in evaluating the research of others and refrain from evaluating the research in case of conflict of interests or personal differences.
- 7. The researcher should direct his research to the benefit of knowledge, society and humanity as a basic ethical obligation by virtue of his job research is conducted in a way that does not ruin future research.
- 8. To enjoy honesty when presenting professional opinions to government bodies or society without harming them.
- 9. When using volunteers in scientific research, they should be informed about the quality and nature of the research and their knowledge of the expected results, as well as the potential damage or risks, and should observe the application of the ethical standards stipulated in the use of volunteers. Their names and not use the information obtained in the non-research purpose.

Objectives of the research plan

1. To study the factors affecting public health in Egypt and the lifestyle and health awareness as well as the resources available to provide primary health care.

- 2. Develop standards and clinical guidelines for public and community health care in line with international standards to improve the quality of nursing performance.
