- 12- To maintain ongoing communication (reports, coordinated visits, meeting attendance) with the University's Measurement and Evaluation Center.

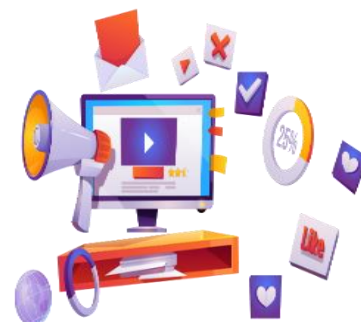
Question Bank Committee

1. Monitor internal review committees and internal systems for assessing intended learning outcomes in the college.
2. Provide support in developing exam questions and test items for various courses.
3. Oversee the process of reviewing and updating the college's question banks.
4. Review standards of confidentiality and security related to question bank management.
5. Review the relative weight of exam questions using the Blueprint.



Publicity and Publication Committee

- 1- Promote a culture of measurement and evaluation among college affiliates.
- 2- Issue quarterly/annual bulletins about the unit's activities.
- 3- Publish annual booklets on the development of measurement and evaluation systems in the college.
- 4- Prepare posters and both print and digital advertisements introducing the unit and its activities.

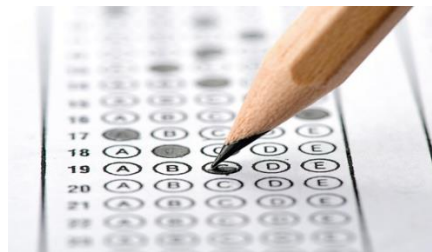


Analysis, Statistics, and Performance Assessment Committee

1. Provide the necessary support for conducting statistical analysis of exams within the college.
2. Prepare statistical analysis reports of the electronic exam grading results.
3. Measure stakeholder satisfaction with the unit's performance and activities on a regular basis.
4. Monitor stakeholder satisfaction with the college's assessment tools and systems.

Electronic Grading and E- Exams Committee

1. Monitor the implementation of electronic grading procedures in the college and issue quarterly reports.
2. Train staff on electronic grading systems.
3. Approve paper-based/electronic exams (in form and content) through the University's Measurement and Evaluation Center after review by the committee.
4. Monitor the development of control rooms and examination procedures (e.g., exam paper review, evaluation of practical/applied courses, exam environment, and modern assessment methods).
5. Update test data systems.



Training Committee

1. Develop and implement training courses/workshops to meet the college's needs regarding measurement and evaluation.
2. Measure the effectiveness and impact of training on the targeted groups.
3. Provide necessary support in exam question development and course-specific test item construction.
