Ethics of scientific research followed by the department

The department is committed to the scientific research ethics charter followed in the faculty, and this constitution commitment, integrity and scientific honesty, respect for intellectual property rights, cooperation, and teamwork. These values and principles represent the framework through which the department seeks to achieve research priorities in the next five years, and the researcher must follow the foundations of the ethics of scientific research in the faculty are as follow:

- 1. The researcher presents his research topic to the Scientific Research Ethics Committee
- 2. The researcher should refrain from using deception in obtaining information
- 3. The researcher must take into account honesty in presenting his results in direct and unobtrusive ways, and he should not present false, artificial or improper results, evidence, results, deductions, or misleading comments.
- 4. The researcher should not practice any kind of discrimination when selecting his research assistants.
- 5. It is taken into account in the research to include only the names of the researchers who actually participated in the research, with an accurate definition of the role of each of them.
- 6. Whoever conducts research arbitration must possess a high capacity of theoretical and scientific information and ensure references so that he can make a good objective evaluation of the research, and he must be impartial and objective in evaluating the research of others and refrain from evaluating the research in case of conflict of interests or disagreements Personal.
- 7. The researcher must direct his research to the benefit of knowledge, society and humanity, and a basic ethical commitment by virtue of his job, and to practice research in a way that does not harm future research.

- 8. To be honest when presenting professional opinions to government agencies or society without harming them.
- 9. When volunteers are used in scientific research, they must be informed of the quality and nature of the research and inform them of the expected results from it, as well as the potential damage or risks, and he must take into account the application of the ethical standards stipulated in the use of volunteers, and keep confidential information obtained about volunteers and not disclose information about volunteers. Their names and not to use the information obtained for other than the research purpose.
