- 3. Updating the research plan in light of Egypt's Vision 2030, the strategy of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, the health problems of Egyptian society, and the reports of the World Health Organization.

- 4. Collect the required data.
- 5. Analyzing the internal and external environment of the college to determine strengths, weaknesses, threats and opportunities (SWOT analysis).
- 6. Reviewing the research plans of the scientific departments.
- 7. Determine the objectives of the Faculty's research plan.
- 8. Developing the Faculty's research plan and discussing it in committee meetings.
- 9. Preparing the action plan, activities and key performance indicators.
- 10. Sending the research plan to the scientific departments to be presented to faculty members for feedback.
- 11. Discussion the feeding back of the plan.
- 12. Developing the final version of the research plan and having it approved by the relevant councils.
